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HOW THIS CURRICULUM GUIDE WORKS:

- Able Moms has provided you within these pages 15 unique lessons and preparation guides for what are typically 14 Gatherings (to include Mom Comm). While every Host and Coordinator is different, our suggested Able Moms schedule is hosting 2 Gatherings per month, breaking in the Summer, and then again around Thanksgiving and Christmas for family time. You would then use our Kickoff Kit to prepare for your upcoming year over the off months.
- Here is our suggested Annual Calendar:
 January -> April = 2 Gatherings per month (to include March 4th Mom Comm Conference)

May + June = Break for Summer

July + August = preparation utilizing Kickoff Kit

September -> December = 2 Gatherings per month (breaking for Holidays)

- Again, we know every Community is different and you may want to start, end, or break
 at different times. This annual curriculum is somewhat flexible and we have also
 provided you one Bonus Gathering for this very reason. (However, our Able Moms Int.
 offices follow the calendar above, rolling out our annual theme in the Spring, new
 curriculum every Summer, and communicating within the seasons and breaks, etc.)
- Make sure your Team Leads and Host agree on the best time and day every two weeks or month. You want to provide consistency for your moms. (Gatherings are 1.5 hours.)
- You will see this curriculum is to be used as a personal preparation guide for you as a Coordinator as well as a guide for the actual Gathering day. We believe preparing your own heart is the best way to lead other moms in their capABLE parenting, unshakeABLE faith, and memorABLE mentorship. With this two-in-one feel, we have also provided schedule blanks to serve as prompts. Here, you will fill in a specific time based on 1) the allotments we have provided you and 2) the time of day you choose for *your* individual Gathering. Make sure to have the Curriculum Guide with you on Gathering Day.
- Be sure you and your Team Leads understand their roles so you as a Coordinator are not personally preparing for more than you should be.
- Lastly, we know there will be variations from Community to Community. Like, you may
 decide to do a dinner buffet or scrap eating all together instead of every table taking
 turns to bring breakfast to "break bread". But just know, the closer you follow our
 suggestions from years of ministry experience, the better your outcome will be. It is
 proven year over year! We are praying for your success.

2022-2023 Gathering Snapshots

(Typically September) Intro Gathering - This year, we reinforce everlasting hope. Truth soothes all worries; it is life-giving, peace-wielding, and all-encompassing. Today, truth feels like it has been hidden...with the reality being it is oh, so accessible. Our theme, 'Truth Awaken', is a call to come back to the simplicity that is Jesus, His gospel, and the love and grace of God's story for our lives. Welcome to Able Moms. We are glad you are here.

Gathering 1 – Emily and her husband struggled terribly to ease their traumatized daughter to sleep every night - until they realized only the supernatural power of God's word would soothe her episodes. Thus, the Tyndale book series *Generation Claimed* was born; board books of thoughtful scriptures to read over your child. But, before this dream took off, Emily shares the real and raw financial battle her family endured that left them homeless in someone's basement. For every mom navigating our penny-pinching era, this gathering is for you.

Gathering 2 – Incredible speaker, ministry founder, and author of *Own Your Assignment* shares about a concept that was once raw and undefined for her; *Spiritual* Mothering. Bethany Hicks shares how every woman is called to "raise" the next generation and how she can embrace her God-given identity and then, her God-ordained assignment, to speak over and into children even those that she didn't physically birth. For every mom who sees what is in their child and wants to encourage it, don't miss this Gathering.

Gathering 3 – Misty is the pioneer of the first-ever Christian podcast conference; 'Spark' and founder of Spark Media. As 'Mom' to a special needs child, she talks about her life in retrospect now that her son is a young adult. She weaves Jesus and wisdom into the day-to-day and shares what a blessing it has been to endure a life she did not anticipate. This gathering is for any mom that has struggled with things "not turning out the way she thought they would".

Gathering 4 – Able Moms International visioneer and CEO, Amanda Florczykowski, shares with bare transparency how overwhelm erupted in her life. She vulnerably shares the reasons why –

which any mom will be able to relate to. Yet, instead of leaving moms in despair, she gives a practical exercise for a path to peace without forsaking progress. She shares her real testimony and how we all can navigate the real tension between calling versus responsibility when drowning in an ocean of overwhelm. Don't miss today if you have felt the suffocation of stress and strain and want everyday answers within a Biblical testimony.

Gathering 5 – April Gordon is a passionate mom of three, a participant in Able Moms' pioneer years, and a most gifted and creative writer. With a boatload of ministry experience and oodles of mom humor, she pulls you into the front row seat of the joys and tumult of raising toddlers...and points you to the redeeming hope of seeing our children *not* for what their messes and mistakes (inherent to childhood) "say" about them now, but for *who* God has made them to be and how we can cultivate a perception that nurtures their great callings. You won't want to miss this gathering if you are in the thick of things and need encouragement.

Gathering 6 – Inspirational storyteller and motivational keynote speaker, Sherry Boykin, is a chronic believer in the power of faith narratives as epilogues that change lives. In other words, she is an AMAZING storyteller. Even our Able Moms Curriculum Planning Committee laughed out loud at her take on a memorable mother-daughter moment. Yet, her deep explanation of Scripture from a sound and seasoned perspective will leave you speechless. Do not miss this gathering if you need something hearty from God's word to ground your soul.

Gathering 7 – "Choice is Yours" Gathering - Every year, Coordinator(s) get to choose a speaker who will knock moms' socks off. Get ready for the Coordinator's big announcement of who it is. We will also hear a special message from our AMI Creator and anti-trafficking advocate, Amanda Florczykowski. This gathering is for anyone who likes to live on the edge!**

Gathering 8 – Jayme Gradwell is an award winning podcaster, mom, and giant of the faith. Truly someone to look up to, she is the epitome of grace and beauty, yet brings a down-to-earth humbleness to any room. This may be because of her own humble journey. Listen as Jayme shares a most humiliating financial struggle and her revelation through the eyes of her son smack in the middle of a Valentine's Day party she didn't want to be at. You will want to attend this gathering and let your heart be soothed by the truth of God's word if you are feeling financial pressure right now.

Gathering 9 – "Speaker Panel" Gathering - Your Mentor Moms take the stage today and tell truth. Truth Awaken. All bets are off as they share openly about motherhood and Biblical womanhood. There is always laughter, vulnerability, maybe some tears...all the fundamentals that deepen the roots of relationship. You will leave closer than when you walked in the door. Do not miss this gathering. Do not.

March Gathering: Mom Comm 2023 - Saturday, March 4th

Gathering 11 – Mrs. Wyoming is also Cheif Development Officer in 'Amanda Flo Ministries' anti- child sex trafficking ministry, Vigilant Families. Her passion for child exploitation came

from her own hellish sojourn that Jesus walked through with her hand-in-hand. She chronicles her story in her book *Me and Jesus Covered in Pee* and today shares how generational sin affected her own family in the most horrific of ways. This gathering is for you if your past has held you back and your heart needs the truthful words of freedom.

Gathering 12 – Felicia Sivells - One of Able Moms first Coordinators, Felicia now works for AMI and shows Hosts and Members the way to this beautiful ministry with an undeniable love for Jesus, moms, and kids. This year, Felicia very transparently guides moms through loss and making sense of what feels messy. While pregnant with twins, the OB informed Felicia she had lost one of the two. She shares her journey of carrying both until full term and what it was like to pray for a miracle and then wrestle with God and His goodness in spite of her emotions. This gathering is for any mom who has felt grief but doesn't yet know how to let go and embrace better.

Gathering 13 – "Testimony" Gathering - It is hard to believe we are at the end already. This gathering is historically every mom's favorite. Today's "open mic" is a chance for YOU to share what Able Moms has meant to you this year and hear what it has meant to others. Bring your phone as you'll have an opportunity at the gathering's end to share as well as join us again next year.

**Coordinator: One Bonus Gathering

Some Communities will choose to go longer, supplement a video, or add a fun evening Gathering. If this is you, here is one extra Gathering for you to use. Additionally, if you do not wish to choose your own speaker for Gathering 7, you can use this Bonus Gathering instead.

Bonus: Gathering 14 - Ambre Thill, lead Women's Ministry Director at mega-church, Calvary of Naperville, Illinois, mom and grandmom, and host to this year's Mom Comm, Ambre is a spirit-filled woman who speaks and the atmosphere changes. Soft and unassuming, you feel like you are in a "mother's lap" yourself as she shares her dark day and the life-altering revelation of putting full surrender and trust in our perfect Father. You don't want to miss this gathering if you need the comfort of a mother yourself.

General Gathering Format



Below is an example of how every Gathering should be conducted.

You have already chosen the meeting time and day that works for your Community. Now, each lesson of your curriculum (usually) has the same Gathering agenda as above, but like page 11, with fill-in-the-blanks. Just place your times in using the outline on this page. This will save you a lot of planning hassle. FYI, Gathering One on page 14 is the first meeting you will be able to practice using this format. Lastly, if there is a change or longer video, it will be noted in the opening paragraph.





- 5. Sometimes circumstances paralyze us and saying 'yes' is hard. How can we say 'yes' to God and press forward towards true *abundance* and not become distracted by temporary ease?
- 6. In Joseph's story, he realized his abundance was for a purpose of something bigger than himself. How would you express your life's

circumstances as being used for your good, the good of others, and for God's glory?

Ask them to recall the memories from each of those days with their children and sit in the beauty of their family togetherness.

Explain that some pictures will inevitably conjure up feelings of "bad days", defeat, exhaustion, and failure. That is ok - because Jesus' blood covers our past, present, and future sins. Our acknowledgement of our weakness and His vastness is what is really crucial.

So, ask your moms to now quietly listen to the Lord. Ask your audience to pause after each question and ponder their responses during this three question exercise:

- 1. "What areas of my motherhood have I been thinking untruthful thoughts about myself and my children?"
- 2. "Have I been mothering from those irrational places?"
- 3. "What truth does Jesus say about me as a mom that I can awaken in my heart and begin to mother from; a much more faith-forward mental space?"
